Built in 1927 this building was originally known as the Jefferson Avenue Evangelical English Lutheran Church.

Jefferson Avenue was one of the first Lutheran churches in Detroit that held services in English. Over the years, this historic and architecturally significant building provided a place of worship and celebration for many Detroiters.

In 2016 this building enters a new era. It will now serve as the Corporate Office, Operations Center and Community Education Venue for the Great Lakes Clean Water/US Clean Water Organization.
