

PART-TIME GIS OPPORTUNITIES on FSU CAMPUS

The Florida Geological Survey (FGS) is in need of two part-time employees with GIS experience. With funding provided by the USGS, these employees will assist FGS GIS and database staff by performing spatial QA / QC on drilled well locations using ArcGIS and other tools. These positions will involve researching historical well archives, using GIS theory and problem solving skills, and may also require researching and updating metadata for selected wells. GIS and database management software will be used to perform well location validation / verification, as well as QA / QC of digital spatial data based on existing paper records.

Experience / skills:

- Experience using ArcGIS version 9.0 or higher – ArcMap, ArcToolbox, and ArcCatalog
- Working knowledge of attribute table operations and SQL querying within ArcMap
- Experience using MS Excel and Access for data import, export, and manipulation
- Basic cartographic interpretation skills
- Familiarity with the Public Land Surveying System (STR) preferred but not required
- Ability to identify recurring spatial patterns resulting from locational errors
- Keen sense of detail and ability to work independently when necessary
