3:10 pm	<b>Presentation</b> <b>Memorial Day Flooding Event: GIS for damage assessment and situational awareness.</b> On May 25 <sup>th</sup> to May 27 <sup>th</sup> , the City of Houston and surrounding areas experienced a 100 year rain fall event, resulting in record flooding along all the major watersheds, with most of the cresting out of their banks and flooding streets, highways and residences. There were seven fatalities and in excess of 6,300 homes flooded in the region. Damage estimates are in excess of \$41 million for City of Houston assets.  The topic of this discussion will be how GIS was used to provide situational awareness, perform damage assessment and provide data to City policy and decision makers.
