3:05 pm	Hazus for Response Operations for Hurricane Irma In September 2017, Hurricane Irma made landfall twice in Florida, once as a Category 4 hurricane in the Keys and again as a Category 3 storm in Marco Island, making Irma the first major hurricane to make landfall in Florida since Hurricane Wilma in 2005. Unlike other storms, hurricane force winds impacted a majority of the state from the Keys to the FL/GA border. FEMA being modeling the impacts of the wind related losses for Irma using Hazus starting 72 hours before landfall though the dissipation of the storm. Final estimates for wind loss estimates for Hurricane Irma range from \$8-\$14 Billion.
