This program is designed to provide the participant with the capabilities of conducting a thorough hazard-risk assessment of chemicals and other forms of hazardous materials. It is designed for the fire officer, hazardous materials technician, hazardous materials enforcement officers or life safety inspector. The program analyzes chemistry as it effects the behavior of hazardous materials and the combustion process. The course is designed to show the different features and forms of matter and energy, common substances, and how they relate to flammability, toxicity and reactivity. The chemical families, names, formulas, their bondings and separations, as well as the different chemical reactions are covered. *This course is Florida State Fire College approved RN3615*.

TARGET AUDIENCE:

Fire department officers and firefighting personnel preparing to serve in the role of fire officer, hazardous material technician, industrial safety officers, small quantity generator or life safety injector.

PROGRAM FORMAT:

This 48 hours program is comprised of approximately 75% classroom lecture and 25% table-top activities and case studies. The participant should anticipate out of class reading, study and research.

Fees for the program are \$395.00 (\$350.00 for employees of Orange County government)


