































































































UNITED STATE POST OFFICE ZIP CODE LOOKUP - USPS.COM

- Get the CORRECT address format of an address
 - Keep in mind CHAZ abbreviations
 - State Road SR
 - o County Road CR
 - o Highway HWY
- Can also get information on if the address receives mail



NEW CHAZ CODES

- Waste Codes
- SRNG Dry Rags (Non-Haz) from Ignitable-Only Solvents
- UPNO Non-haz oils (cooling, etc)
- Disposal Codes
- NH Non-haz management (tested/confirmed)
- NQ Non-haz management (not tested/questionable)

SRNG - DRY RAGS (NON-HAZ)

- Use for rags with ignitable-only solvents that have dried
- Examples: acetone, petroleum distillates, mineral spirits, xylene
- Defaults to "NO" for hazardous waste box; although garbage/landfill still defaults to questionable
- Use new "NH" nonhazardous (confirmed) disposal code

Use SRNG for dry rags

- Previous option was SRIG (rags with ignitable-only solvents)
- But...when you put the garbage for storage and landfill for disposal, storage and disposal came up questionable; and hazardous Waste defaulted to "YES"

Instead of SRIG - ignitable rags

UPNO - NON-HAZ OILS (COOLING, ETC)

- Use for waste oil (not recycled)
- Examples: cooling oil from fabricators
- Waste determination needs to be done
- Use new "NH" nonhazardous (confirmed) disposal code, OR
 "NO" - not
- tested/questionable
- Previous option was UPEO (used oil)
 - But waste oil that is not recycled is not "used
 - e.g. Cooling oils with metal shavings
- Previous disposal option was "EU" - used oil recycling

Use UPNO - non-haz oils

Instead of UPEO - used oil

NH - NON-HAZARDOUS DISPOSAL (TESTED/CONFIRMED)

- New disposal code for wastes we regulate, but are have been confirmed nonhazardous
 - Through testing or generator knowledge
- RCRA field defaults to
 "NO"

Use NH - non-haz disposal (tested/confirmed)

- Paint booth filters
- Aqueous parts washers
- Waste oil (cooling, etc)
- Rags used with ignitable-only solvents
- Oily sludges (from pump-outs)
