Attached is a draft of the RCRA Public Participation Manual, 2016 Edition that, when finalized, will replace and supersede the 1996 Public Participation Manual (EPA 530-R-96-007). We developed the Manual with input from a national workgroup that included members from OLEM, OECA, OGC and Regions. The Agency is now seeking public comment on the draft Manual from August 9, 2016, through September 9, 2016. Along with the draft Manual, we are posting a document, RCRA Public Participation Manual: Advantages of Public Involvement that briefly describes the Manual and poses a set of questions to prompt comments.

The new *Manual* is intended as a "user's manual." It explains how public participation works in the RCRA permitting process (including corrective action), and how community members, tribes, regulators, and industry can collaborate to make it more effective. The *Manual* reviews regulatory requirements, and provides policy guidance to help implement the RCRA program. In addition, the updated *Manual* describes a wide assortment of activities to enhance public participation, highlights the use of digital and social media, provides a guide to integrate public participation into the permit modification process, and incorporates lessons learned and best practices.

The *Manual* represents EPA's commitment to engage stakeholders in the decision-making process of the RCRA hazardous waste management program. It adopts a community involvement approach similar to the one expressed in the Superfund Community Involvement Handbook - that trust, transparency, and a commitment to addressing community concerns are key elements of successful community involvement programs.
